Poole was raised in Marengo County and graduated from the University of Alabama and the University of Alabama School of Law. He has been a general practice attorney in Tuscaloosa since 2004.

In 2010, he was elected as Chairman of the Tuscaloosa County Legislation Committee and in 2013, appointed as Chairman of the Ways and Means Education Committee.

After serving his first legislative session in 2011, he was identified by veteran lawmakers interviewed by the Mobile Press-Register as the top member out of 34 new lawmakers in the Alabama House of Representatives.

He is involved in several community groups, including the West Alabama Chamber of Commerce, Outback America and as a member of the Board of Directors for the Boys and Girls Club of West Alabama.
